On November 20th, 23 people from our association drove up to Ringgold, GA to serve a Thanksgiving meal at Cherokee Valley Baptist Church for the April tornado victims and the church who has ministered faithfully for these past several months. Over 150 people from the community attended this dinner cooked by the wonderful cooks from our association. We served turkey and ham, dressing, cranberry sauce, sweet potato soufflé, green beans, rolls, and dessert. We also gave \$100 Walmart gift cards to 17 families who had been affected by the tornadoes. I am very grateful for everyone in our association who made this possible—those who cooked and those who served.

We recently received a thank you note from one of the families:

“Dear folks at Carrollton Baptist Association, We received a Walmart gift card from you a few weeks ago at Cherokee Valley Baptist Church and want to thank you for the love you have shown towards the tornado victims in our area. We have been so blessed by the servants of the Lord since April 27th. The Lord has provided for all our needs through godly people like you. May Adonai bless you and keep you

and cause his face to shine toward you. In Jesus name, Tony, Tina, Sean, Evan, AJ and Erica”

We are in the process now of assisting the rebuilding of 5 homes in the Trenton area (Dade County). We are working with Jim Boyd of Rebuilding Hope and have recently purchased the framing materials for one home. Our hope is that our association through the gifts of our churches and individuals following the tornado, will be able to purchase the framing materials for at least 3 of these homes. We had several teams go up to Ringgold to assist and I hope we will have several other teams to assist in Trenton. If you are interested in taking a team up to Trenton, give me a call.

Thank you for the tremendous response to Operation Christmas Child. Overall 3,271 shoeboxes were packed in our office and taken to Newnan. Although we did not make our goal of 3300 shoeboxes, it was still a tremendous outpouring of love for boys and girls around the world who might not receive something for Christmas. I am grateful for Lewis and Gloria North and Pat and Charlotte Culwell who headed up this project for us and to the many volunteers who gave their time to work here at the office collecting and packing the boxes. It was definitely a team effort and because it was a team effort much was accomplished. I am also grateful for Steve

and Scottie Jennings who always carry the packed boxes to Newnan for us in their Furniture House truck. I believe this is the tenth year they have supplied the truck and driver.

It’s hard to believe that a new year is beginning in just a few days. Where did 2011 go? It seems like only yesterday I was writing 2011 on my checks and now it will be 2012. I hope 2011 was a wonderful year for you and your church and that you are looking to turning the page to another great year. From the WMU...

Someone shared an email message with me that was sent from Tom Eliff, IMB President. He told of a recent trip he made to Africa over Thanksgiving. The workers were encouraged to see some people from a village they had been praying for. Eliff reminded us the Light of the Gospel will break across the landscape in that distant community...the result of YOUR praying, YOUR giving, YOUR praying some more!

In early December we focused on prayer for our personnel and giving to international missions through the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, which keeps personnel on the field. It is so important to keep our missionaries before us all the time by praying and giving and praying some more. Eliff tells us "we must both pray and give with sacrificial determination. But if we can continue wearing what we wear, living

where we live, enjoying all that we have enjoyed and going anywhere we want to go...then where is the sacrifice? Sacrifice results in change, a present change in our lives with the anticipation of future change in the lives of others. It will take sacrificial giving, praying and going if Southern Baptist are to effectively impact the world for Christ sake. This year, let's pray and give and pray some more...like people who take the Great Commissions seriously. Let's do everything necessary to be His Heart, His Hands and His Voice."

What a challenge he presents to us. It should cause us to evaluate how we live, how we might change, and consider what we might do. You can find a list of missionaries in Mission Mosaic to pray for.
